

# Activities you can do at home

## Mathematics

Sing counting rhymes with me like “1,2,3,4,5 Once I Caught a Fish Alive

Let me build from cardboard boxes or wooden bricks.  
Use words like “long” and “tall” to describe my model.



## Literacy

Make a name card for my bedroom or A placemat. Let me use these to help me to try and write my name by Myself.

Read signs to me when we are out and about.

Let me help you write a shopping list.

## Communication and Language

Talk to me about the things We did or places we have visited.

Make sock puppets or story boxes with me to help me retell my favourite stories.

## Physical Development

Let me practise using child's scissors to cut dough, cooked spaghetti or paper.

Make an obstacle course in the park or my garden where I have to run around benches, crawl under blankets and through cardboard boxes.

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Make dens from sheets and blankets that I can play in with you or my friends.

Talk to me about how to keep safe when we are crossing the road.



## Expressive Arts and Design

Let me use my paints to mix up my own colours.

Help me to use some of my toys to help make up a story.

Sing and dance with me to my favourite songs.

## Understanding of the World

Let me help you water the plants.

Plant seeds with me in a pot or in the garden.

Let me use a camera to take pictures.

Let me taste foods from different countries and cultures.


# Home Learning Challenges
