Answer quick fire questions.</p> <p>Don't forget the inverse operations; in this case division is the 'inverse' or opposite of multiplication</p> <p>For example every time you practise $5 \times 3 = 15$, make sure to recite the other three variations including the inverse ie</p> <p>If we know $5 \times 3 = 15$, we also know $3 \times 5 = 15$, $15 \div 3 = 5$ and $15 \div 5 = 3$</p> | <p></p> <p>Write a story.</p> <p>The idea for your story is 'Through the doorway.'</p> <p>Where is the doorway? What type of door is it?</p> <p>Perhaps your character will find something on the other side of the door or maybe the door will be locked.</p> <p>Think about the following</p> <p>Who are your characters? Where is the story set? What is the problem and how will it be solved? How will your story end?</p> <p>Remember to</p> <p>Plan your story with a beginning, middle and an end Organise your ideas into paragraphs Choose your words carefully to entertain the reader Write in sentences Pay attention to your spelling and punctuation Check and edit your work carefully</p> | <p>Remember Jesus taught us to love one another.</p> <p>Could you show this love by doing something special for somebody at home or write a special prayer and share it with a loved one using the internet?</p> <p></p> <p>Times of prayer are opportunities to spend time with Jesus.</p> <p>Use some quiet time to talk to Jesus and listen to him.</p> |

Science

Find your pulse (ask an adult to help you if you can't find it) This is a measurement of your heart beat. When you have found it, count how many beats occur in one minute. Now jump up and down or run around for one minute. Take your pulse again for another minute. What has happened to your heart beat? (Your heart rate increases because the heart needs to pump blood containing oxygen around the body more quickly to the muscles in the body.)


