



Bikeability L1 Consent Letter – During School Day

Dear Year 4 Parents / Carers

On **Friday 29th January 2021** Year 4 children have been offered the opportunity to take part in Bikeability Level 1 **FREE of Charge** during school time. This is a national scheme funded by the Department for Transport and provided through Stoke City Council.

The course is delivered by Nationally Qualified Cycling Instructors and has been revised in line with current Education and Government advice. We have reduced participation to 12 children max per instructor (previously 15 per course). Adhering to social distancing, Bikeability is an active, outdoor activity where pupils are on their own bikes, 2+ meters apart and riding for 80% of the time.

Level 1 takes place on the school playground. There are a number of outcomes to be taught so riders gain basic cycle skills including, bike safety checks, starting and stopping under control, signalling and using gears correctly. This course is a sound introduction to Level 2 on-road training which your child can progress onto aged 10 or 11. This is offered annually by your school.

All who take part will receive a badge and certificate.

Your child needs signed consent, must be able to ride a bike and requires their own maintained bike. We recommend wearing a cycling helmet but in the event of your child not owning one we would not prevent them from taking part. Parental permission must be given if no helmet is being worn.

There are a limited number of places remaining so Parents/Carers must **complete the tear off slip and return to school by Tuesday 8th December 2020.**
